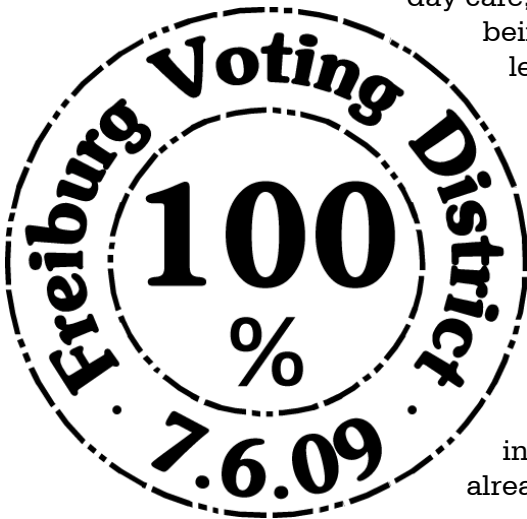


Whoever lives in Freiburg should also have the right to vote!

Let's vote!

On June 7, 2009 communal elections will be held in Freiburg for the city council's next legislative period. The Freiburg municipal area is home to more than 157,000 citizens who, coming election Sunday, will be of legal age and will have been officially registered in Freiburg for more than three months. 8,700 EU nationals will be eligible to vote as well. **But** 13,500 citizens of Freiburg will not be allowed to vote because they do not have German or EU citizenship and therefore will not be eligible to vote. In addition to the official Freiburg voting district, Freiburg residents with foreign citizenship will be able to vote in the symbolic Freiburg Voting District 100%.

Whoever lives in Freiburg is directly affected by public transportation prices, available day care, or decisions concerning municipal housing - independent of being born in Freiburg, Hamburg, Madrid, Ankara, or Duala. All legal-age residents of a city should be equally entitled to elect their communal parliament independent of birthplace or passport. The Freiburg Council of Foreigners as well as the Freiburg City Council advocates this view. A two-thirds majority vote in the upper house of the federal parliament, however, is necessary for the enactment of a law allowing universal communal suffrage for foreigners.



The right to participate in universal, free, and secret elections is a basic principle of a democratic state system. Foreign citizen participation in elections promotes integration and expresses social and political equality. This is already common practice in 17 of 27 EU countries.

We invite you, like your German neighbours, to combine your Sunday walk with a stroll to the polls. On the ballot you may cast your symbolic vote for the parties and representative of the Freiburg City Council. Voting hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Voting requirements are proof of legal age as well as minimum residency of three months in the city of Freiburg. Names will not be registered. German and EU citizens are invited to show their support with a solidarity vote.
